Are you interested in pursuing your studies abroad with a fully funded scholarship? Consider applying for the Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship Programme—an opportunity to study in Hungary, the heart of Europe, known for its rich history, innovation, and vibrant cultural life.

The scholarship offers full tuition coverage supplemented with some extra allowance, allowing you to focus entirely on your academic goals. You can choose to apply for partial studies (1 or 2 semesters) at your current study level or take your academic journey further by applying to a full-degree master's or doctoral program.

This scholarship is available for any Hungarian higher education institution, but we strongly recommend the programmes offered at our partner university Budapest University of Economics and Business (BUEB). Applications typically open in the beginning of November, with deadlines of 15 January. During this time, you'll need to choose your preferred programme and contact your sending partner (i.e., the Ministry of Higher Education in Malaysia) to ensure you meet their requirements and deadlines and submit your application.
