

Semester exchanges or research exchange semesters at Hochschule Heilbronn – University of Applied Sciences

2 students for the Winter Semester, 2026 or Summer Semester, 2027

Winter semester (WS): €900 per month for 6 months + €1,735 travel allowance

Nomination deadline at HHN: 11 May 2026 for WS2026/27

Summer semester (SS): €900 per month for 5 months + €1,735 travel allowance

Nomination deadline at HHN: 15th November 2026 for SS2027

WS period: September - February

Beginning of lecture period: End of September (28.09.2026)

SS period: March - August

Beginning of lecture period: mid-March

Top-up for students with fewer opportunities: €250/month

Student must fall in one of the following criteria to qualify:

- Top-up for students with child/children (mobility with child)
- Top-up for students with disabilities
- Top-up for students with chronic illnesses, who require additional financial needs during the mobility
- Top-up for first-time students
- Top-up for employed students

The conditions that have to be fulfilled in order to receive the respective top-ups, as well as the evidence that must be presented upon request, are detailed on page 2 of the attached document.

*** Important note to student: Scholarship payments will start after you arrived in Germany and have opened a German bank account. No payments will be made to non-European bank accounts. Please ensure you have sufficient funds available to cover initial costs and expenses for the first 2–3 weeks in Germany, estimated at approximately €2,000–2,500 (student dormitory/housing deposit, healthcare/student insurance of around 125€/M, flight, etc.), prior to arrival.

The monthly student rate for a statutory health insurance in Germany is around € 150 (students under 30).
